Carvin Eison is an expert in television, film and video

production. A two-time New York State Emmy® Award nominee for his documentary *July '64*, Eison is currently working on his newest projects, both of which have grown out of his work on *July '64*. The first, a 30-minute documentary/profile on Minister **Franklin Florence** and the FIGHT organization in Rochester, NY. This project again focuses on local and regional history. The second project, currently in preproduction is *Penumbra*, in which Eison is exploring how lynching developed, thrived and eventually diminished in the US. *Penumbra* is a national project with the potential of becoming a feature narrative film.

Tukufu Zuberi is a leading sociologist studying African demography as well as methodological and ethical issues in social scientists' approach to race. His books include *Swing Low, Sweet Chariot: The Mortality Cost of Colonizing Liberia in the Nineteenth Century* and *Thicker Than Blood: How Racial Statistics Lie*. He has recently co-edited *The Demography of South Africa*.

Dr. Zuberi regularly co-hosts PBS's *History Detectives* program in which four researchers investigate artifacts and reveal details of the social history surrounding the objects.

Directions to SUNY Brockport

From points east:

- From NYS Thruway Exit 45 (Victor) take I-490 through Rochester and west to exit 8 for Route 531.
- Take 531 to the end at Washington Street. Follow signs to Brockport (six miles) by taking Route 31 west.
- Follow signs to the College. Enter the campus at Commencement Drive.

From points west:

- From NYS Thruway Exit 47 (LeRoy) take Route 19 north to Brockport (about 13 miles).
- Follow signs to the College. Enter the campus at Commencement Drive.

From points south:

- From Interstate 390 north, take I-490 west.
- Follow directions from points east, above. Exit 8 is one mile west of I-390.
